SUBJECT

**EXHAUST BRAKE
BACKPRESSURE SETTING**

Field reports have indicated some confusion exists between preset exhaust brakes and non preset units. Preset exhaust brakes have a red tag attached which indicates the part number and preset pressure, this must be matched to the engine manufactures recommended maximum backpressure as per Pacbrake application guide.

Exhaust brakes which have not been preset have a tag attached that states a road test is required to adjust the backpressure. It is the responsibility of the installer to assure the backpressure of non preset exhaust brakes is to the engine manufacturers specifications.
